City of Delano leases Golf Course to Monterey Management Group



As of June 18, 2012, the City of Delano has leased the Delano Golf Course to Monterey Management Group. With the golf course under new management, new changes will be implemented.

The Monterey Management Group also has plans to create various programs that will offer lessons to adults and pre-lessons to the youth. The new management will also pursue golf tournaments.

City Held its 4th Annual Fair Housing Arts Contest

The City of Delano's Economic Development Department held its 4th Annual Fair Housing Arts Award Ceremony on May 16 at the City of Delano Civic Center with a little over 70 in attendance. This year's contest received 149 entries in which 28 winners were honored. The City awarded \$1,050 worth of contest prizes.

The purpose of the Fair Housing Arts Contest is to raise awareness of the Fair Housing Act amongst the youth and to commemorate the Fair Housing Month of April. This year's contest theme was Fair Housing: For your Family and Mine. Students from grades K-12 were encouraged to submit an arts submission that relates to the theme

of fair housing. Grades 6-12 also had the option of submitting an essay.

Prize-winning entries were selected on their originality, content and the incorporation of the fair housing into the theme. All winners were presented with a trophy and the top three in each category received a cash prize. First place winners were awarded \$75, second place winners were awarded \$50 and third place winners were awarded \$25.
