Sobriety/Driver's License Checkpoint:

The Delano Police Department Traffic Unit conducted a Sobriety/Driver's License Checkpoint on Friday, August 23, 2019. The checkpoint was located within the eastbound lane of the 1200 block of Cecil Avenue and operated between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 12:00 a.m. Weather conditions were clear and roadways were dry. Five hundred and eighty-four (584) vehicles passed through the checkpoint, twenty (20) of those vehicles were screened. One (1) driver; was further evaluated and arrested for operating a motor vehicle while impaired (alcohol). Officers issued ten (10) citations, ranging from misdemeanor violations to traffic infractions. The average time delay of motorists was less than one (1) minute.
