Special Event Permit for your Outdoor Holiday Special Event



Interested in selling flowers, balloons or other types of merchandise for this upcoming Valentine's Day? If so, you must obtain a Special Event Permit for your Outdoor Holiday Special Event on private commercial property.

Fee: \$155.00 – Non refundable fee for each occurrence

Submittal of application:

The special event permit application should be submitted a minimum of 20 days before the event.

Requirements:

- Submit Special Event Application
- Site plan- depicting the building, parking lot and where the event will be held
- Business license issued by the City of Delano Finance Department
- Insurance coverage of \$1 million – Insurance Certificate Holder should state "City of Delano, its officers, its employees, boards and commissions as additional insured"
- Property owner's signed approval and authorization
- All on-site signs (existing or proposed) including size, height, material, color or lighting.

The Delano Police Department is asking the citizens of Delano to take responsibilities for their dogs and cats. Your pets can cause problems for your neighbors and for our Animal Control staff. Make sure that your pets are safe by confining them in your yard and not allowing them to roam the streets. They can cause traffic accidents or attack people. Your pets should also be vaccinated and registered with the city of Delano. It is your responsibility to keep your animals safe and to follow the City of Delano's municipal code. If you are in violation of any ordinance the Delano Animal Control officers will issue citations to those violators.

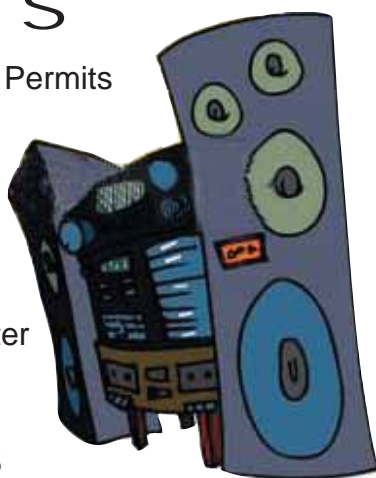

The City of Delano reached its deadline for compliance of the Arsenic Mitigation Project and was successful in lowering the Arsenic levels in the City water system.

This project was set up with the California Department of Health and Federal Environmental Protection Agency to assist the city in lowering the Arsenic levels.

Some components of this project will continue until the summer of 2013.
