Areas of Focus:

Throughout the month of December the traffic division will conduct high-visibility enforcement in the Woollomes Avenue corridor and Main Street, in a continued effort to keep roadways safe.

Special Operations:

The Delano Police Department Traffic Division conducted a Sobriety / Driver's License Checkpoint on Friday, November 16, 2018 within the northbound lane of the 1500 block of Fremont Street. The checkpoint operated between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 12:30 a.m. Weather conditions were clear and roadways were dry. Three hundred and thirty-one (331) vehicles passed through the checkpoint, forty (40) of those vehicles were screened. No drivers were further evaluated to determine their sobriety influence level and no vehicles were impounded by this agency. Officers of the Delano Police Department issued thirty (30) citations, ranging from misdemeanor violations to traffic infractions. Average time delay of motorists was less than one (1) minute.
