DUI/Driver's License Checkpoint:

The Delano Police Department Traffic Unit conducted a DUI / Driver's License Checkpoint on Saturday, December 7, 2019. The checkpoint was located within the northbound lane of the 1000 block of High Street and operated between the hours of 7:30 p.m. and 1:00 a.m. Weather conditions were mostly cloudy with intermittent rain. Two hundred and thirty-eight (238) vehicles passed through the checkpoint, twenty-one (21) of those vehicles were screened. One (1) driver was evaluated, however determined not under the influence. Officers issued ten (10) citations, ranging from misdemeanor violations to traffic infractions. The average time delay of motorists was less than one (1) minute.

DUI Saturation Patrol:

The Delano Police Department Traffic Unit conducted a DUI Saturation Patrol on Saturday, December 21, 2019. The detail operated between the hours of 1900 hours through 0300 hours. Five sworn and one non-sworn personnel participated in this detail. Over fifty (50) traffic enforcement stops were conducted and eight (8) motorists were issued citations for operating a vehicle without a license or on a suspended/revoked license. No arrests or significant occurrences occurred during this DUI Saturation Patrol.
