

## **July 2021 Activity Report Delano Police Department**

### **Chief's Office:**

- Was appointed Interim Chief of Police

### **Problem Oriented-Policing "POP":**

- (June 2021) Coordinated an Illegal Firework Detail with Kern County Fire Department personnel, Obtained Kern County Administration Citations for patrol officers, located areas within City of Delano generating "Calls for Service" for illegal fireworks, assisted with educating the public by creating a flyer/power point for illegal fireworks. (Results: Seven (7) subjects cited, and "Calls for Service (CFS)" for illegal fireworks were drastically reduced (2020- 172 CFS) and (2021- 95 CFS).
- Contacted ABC for a business located at 700 block of 12th Avenue regarding a PC 245 that occurred on the property, ABC advised they would conduct a follow-up investigation on the business.
- Address a letter to the Property Owner for a property located at 2300 block of Patton Street, tenants are considered a public nuisance and residence deemed an "Officer Safety Hazard".
- Contacted the Property Owner for a property located at 1300 block of 12th Avenue, regarding assistance with a "squatter" who refuses to leave.
- Received a complaint regarding a large truck gathering, coordinated with the Traffic Officer for further assistance.
- Coordinated with local resources with helping a misplaced family involving three small juveniles, obtained essentials, hotel vouchers, transportation, and a one-way ticket back to Tennessee.

- Contacted City of Delano employees regarding 901 Ellington Street (Cesar Chavez Park), regarding homeless encampment and various Delano Municipal Code violations. Also coordinated with local resources, Flood Bakersfield Ministries Outreach Team, and Delano Recovery Station to provide resources with the unsheltered population in the area. Contacted City of Delano employees for clean-up of the area.
- Contacted the Property Owner for a property located at 300 block of High Street, regarding a trespasser refusing to leave. Subject was taken to the Delano Recovery Station for assistance. Flood Bakersfield Ministries was also contacted for temporary housing assistance.
- Assisted CAL-TRANS with clean-up of the 2000 block of High Street, regarding homeless encampment.
- Attended meeting regarding the Explorer Program.
- Attended meetings with the Department Chaplains.
- Field Interviewed six (6) new unsheltered individuals.
- Assisted Flood Bakersfield Ministries with providing resources to unsheltered individuals throughout the City of Delano.
- Two (2) case numbers assigned regarding POP.
- Assisted the Patrol Division with responding to "Calls for Service" being generated and taking reports.
